The proposed project involves buffer encroachments necessary to construct a 24-inch gas pipeline within an existing easement. The newly constructed pipeline will cross 28 streams (24 in the Etowah River Basin and 4 in the Chattahoochee River Basin) and their associated buffers. Each crossing will be as close to perpendicular as possible. The 7.5 mile long pipeline project is located between East Cherokee Drive and County Line Road in Cherokee County. The project will require 2,445 linear feet of buffer impacts along Smithwick Creek, Buzzard Flapper Creek, Board Tree Creek, Cobb Creek and various unnamed tributaries to each of the named streams.
